- 1. Problems to be solved (justification of the need of the transnational cooperation)

 - Problem with the growing rate of illness though Roma people due to the lack of knowledge on how to maintain personal hygiene, how to maintain proper living environment, etc.
 - Problem with the interaction between Roma people and indigenous people due to the growing rate of Roma people who live by begging instead of working
 - Problem with the behavior, expression, mentality, etc. through the Roma children, due to the large families and the lack of needed intention and cares.

2. Objectives to be achieved

Improving the quality of life of Roma people through providing a free of charge e-learning platform for education.

3. Main transnational activities (as provisionally planned, to be confirmed with partners)

- Conducting a research though the Roma people for finding out what kind of trainings will be useful for them:
 - o when starting a new job
 - o to maintain personal hygiene
 - to maintain proper living environment
 - o to raise a healthy and willing children, etc.
- Summarizing the results from the research in order to choose the most suitable trainings which has to be elaborated to stimulate and encourage the Roma people to improve the quality of their life
- Development of e-learning platform which will be accessible from all over the world
- Elaboration of educational materials in different languages which will be uploaded in the e-learning platform. There will be different series of trainings on issues which are estimated as a result of the conducted research
- Developing a forum where the Roma people all over the world will be able to exchange experience, knowledge, advises, etc.
- Conducting training for administrative and technical staff for operation and maintenance of the e-learning platform
