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Brief description of the Transnational cooperation:

1. **Problems to be solved** (justify the need of the transnational cooperation)

Developing new industrial areas is all about creating "hardware": reconversing brownfields, the construction of warehouses and buildings, the scheduling of road infrastructure and energy supply, Our idea is to introduce the "software" planning into the development of industrial areas, more specific the employment of blue collar workers. In the local community of Willebroek and the city of Boom, between Antwerp and Brussels, we think different stakeholders have a joint interest in this "software", e.g. the local authorities, the provincial economical development agency, the local industry, the population that lives nearby these industrial areas.

The "software" we will focus on is the creation of jobs for low skilled unemployed people in order to offer the opportunity for reintegration into the labour market. Typically these new industrial area's are located in regions with a pre-industrial history, inhabited mainly by blue collar workers and characterised by small housing.

Levanto has no experience in this approach yet and we don't know of any expertise in Flanders. Therefore we seek for an international partner to either import their approach or - in case no such experience exists yet - to jointly develop a model.

2. Objectives to be achieved

The aim of this project is to collaborate with the different stakeholders in the development of a new industrial area and discover the jobs that can be created for low skilled unemployed people. More specifically, these possibilities can be: logistics, trash treatment, mobility (bikes), cleaning, maintenance of green area's,
