Brief description of the Transnational cooperation:

1. **Problems to be solved** (justification of the need of the transnational cooperation)

Issue of abuse against children is on the top of social agenda in all European Union (EU) countries. Also many recent EU policy documents stress the necessity to solve issues related abuse against children.

Often children as victims of violence within family receive necessary social rehabilitation, while the families of abused children receive insufficient help from the professionals, or do not receive any support at all (understanding the abuse against children in forms of sexual, physical, emotional and neglect).

The project activities will identify best practices and minimum standards for professional work with these families, development and implementation of the relevant program.

Since 1st January, 2010 Latvia Children's Fund is responsible for the administration of the state funds for social rehabilitation of abused children in the crises/rehabilitation centres and at their place of residence. Still no programs for the work with these children's families are available, nor also developed. In the meantime all involved field specialists stress the necessity to work also with the family during the child's rehabilitation process.
