Brief description of the Transnational cooperation:

1. Problems to be solved (justification of the need of the transnational cooperation)

At present, the unemployment rate in europaen countries is steadily increasing. Due to different conditions which hinder the reduction of this quota, countries need to adjust to a growing number of people suffering from long-term unemployment. With a transnational cooperation we would be bring our experiences in the field of long-term unemployed integration and qualification of people with multiple placement constraints. In addition, a bilateral exchange of the two partner countries gives new impetus so as to learn from each other.

2. Objectives to be achieved

With the transfer of knowledge between the partner countries in terms of th activation and mobilization of long-term unemployed people should be developed strategies to reduce the unemployment rate. Our experiences in successful networking should support the work of the different labor market actors. And the networking should be expand beyond the international borders.

The experience from Germany in terms of imparting key skills, motivation, mobility, activation / empowerment should be taken into account.
